

Meeting Sunday 14th 2015

Participiciants: Nicole, Doris (protocol), James, Klaus and, first time with us, Rohini from "Asha for Education", Chapter Delhi.

Short introduction by Doris who welcomed Rohini Muthuswami as our ambassador for our projects in Delhi.

Rohini remembered that she was the one who recommended to noon.ch the projects of organisations like Sadrag, CFH and Nature, with whom we still work prosperously together.

Rohini gave an update about the Delhi-Projects CFH and Nature. She had talked before with Arpana from CFH and Amita of Nature.

Concern for Humanitiy

Rohini: Centres have been closed down because of the heat which was 45 C in the last weeks. CFH is going fine. Arpana sent the teachers to a teachers training program for maths.

Asha Frankfurt provided school bags and school material for the children.

James: Noon wants to implement an additional nutrition program for the centres. Noon recommended Bananas, Oranges and Parle G Biscuits. James is waiting for response by Arpana.

Doris raised the question about dividing the 5 centres between Noon / Asha. If everybody agrees, we would be fine with this. If it starts any kind of confusion we remain in status quo.

NATURE

Rohini: Nature will have 80 children this year in projects supported by noon (25 new children). Amita moved the projects to a new place in C Block, which is very near the school at Tagore garden. Amita wants to have more information about the nutrition program. It wasn't clear for her. Rohini will visit the school as soon as possible.

Nicole raised questions about the other people and organisations which finance Nature and the problem with the permanent FCRA for Nature.

Rohini will find out who else is financing Nature.

Rohini: supposes that the process for FCRA takes so long because of the new Government. Nature should apply for permanent FCRA.
