1. Sirgu Yadav 19 Yrs. and Rakesh Pal 17 Yrs. participated in special olympic Bharat at state level Tournaments and bagged 8 medals in total including 2 gold medal each in different events of Athletic and a special game called Baucci. They were selected for national level special Olympic at Secundrabad (A.P.) and brought 3 medals including one gold each and one silver. It's a very good opportunity for mentally retarded children to participate in game and thanks to W.L.C. who made it possible by gladly accepting the proposal to send these students and an escort to Lucknow and Secundrabad.
2. Sirgu Yadav is selling milk under our income generation programme. We have taken such initiative as an experimental basis.
